
PKC GROUP UPDATE



Lacon's Forge by the River Dee at New Bridge is an important piece of our industrial history. The site also had a blast furnace which was coke fired and predated 1800 rivalling both Coal Brook Dale and Brymbo in technology. The works sighted next to the river for motive power provided by a water wheel proves the early development of the iron industry in our area pre-dating the invention of the beam steam engine by James Watt. Building a blast furnace near a river was a risky business, as it would then be liable to flooding when the river rose during heavy rain fall and it is recorded that a blast furnace in the area did explode at some point in the early 1800's.

Coal and Iron Stone were fed to the blast furnace via a tramroad that ran from the works to the delph where several pits were working. Our area has iron stone which is a very rich form of iron ore and why it is called iron stone rather than ore. The iron content is more than 30% as opposed to iron ores which are less. The indications of the iron still in the ground below our community can be seen by the reddish leachate that still seeps into the River Dee today.

The tramroad that connected Lacon's Forge to the Delph was also an important and leading technological development for the time. It ran from the forge through Ty Mawr Country Park and the lower fields before continuing up what we now call Cae Gwilym & Bro Gwilym Lane, Bowens Lane and then along King Street on the way



to the Delph past what was once called Big Pit before crossing the A539. It passed through what was Air Products so providing a link between the oldest iron works and the last of the iron works separated by almost 200 years.

The site was sold to the British Iron Company in 1825 and work continued for a while but a decline in the iron market in the mid-1830s caused the forge to cease operations. However, it, the coal and rich iron stone had served to help attract the canal to what became Cefn Mawr.
