#### SAFE PLACES

Cefn Community Council are now signed to the Safe Places Scheme. The scheme is run nationwide, in Wales the first one being Wrexham County Borough. It was originally designed for people with learning difficulties

but is now available for all who feel vulnerable. A network of safe places is needed for people to go to in times of need, for example to make a phone call. The user can download an app on their mobile phone which will show the available places within the borough who are currently in the scheme.

The safe place can be any venue open to the public, for example a shop, library, pub or café anyone can join the scheme if they are open to the public. The safe place will have a yellow sticker on the window. The user will be issued with an identifiable card free of charge which must be shown when entering the public place which has registered with the scheme. The safe place will support the user to phone their contact number on the card and support them safely until support arrives, or they wish to leave.

I'm pleased to report that following a training session in relation to the scheme held in the George Edwards Hall, **Tesco Cefn Mawr** have signed up to the scheme. This is the first supermarket in Wrexham to have registered. Well Done Tesco!

#### NIGHTINGALE HOUSE OUTREACH AT CHIRK



Nightingale House Hospice is taking its specialist patient and carer support into the community. Kay Ryan, their Outpatient Services Coordinator at Nightingale House Hospice says it will provide information, advice and support for those who need it. The new outreach facility in Chirk Community Hospital enables patients and their loved ones to tap into a wealth of expertise and services within a community setting, with a chance to speak to someone about what a patient is going through or worried about. The new project makes it easier for patients living in these areas to access services. It will also help de-mystify the image of a hospice only being available for end of life care. The hospice helps patients lead an improved quality of life even with a life-limiting illness. Many people do not know that we helps patients to access numerous services they may not know are available to them such as bereavement support, art and music therapy, drop-in sessions, and complementary therapy, as well as clinical support if required. The majority of people don't realise the range of services we offer. We can also signpost other services with the help of District Nurses, Community Palliative Care and Nurse Specialists in hospital or via their GP based on their needs at the time. Our services aim to meet the needs of patients and families who attend. It may be their physical or emotional well-being that they are struggling with or it could be family or work worries. We hope that by having an Outreach Service it will enable people who do wish to attend the Hospice to still access our support. It provides the opportunity for them talk to us and for us to be able to provide information and support that will allay their fears and help them to address their problems.

The most special and satisfying aspect of the job is being able to make a difference at a time when some people think that no-one can help them. Nightingale House Outreach is available at: Chirk Community Hospital on Tuesdays from 10am to 12.30pm.
